Nova Scotia High School Certificate



Only 7 credits at Grade 10 level count but you can have more. You must have at least 5 credits at Grade 12 level but take more to give you more learning opportunities.

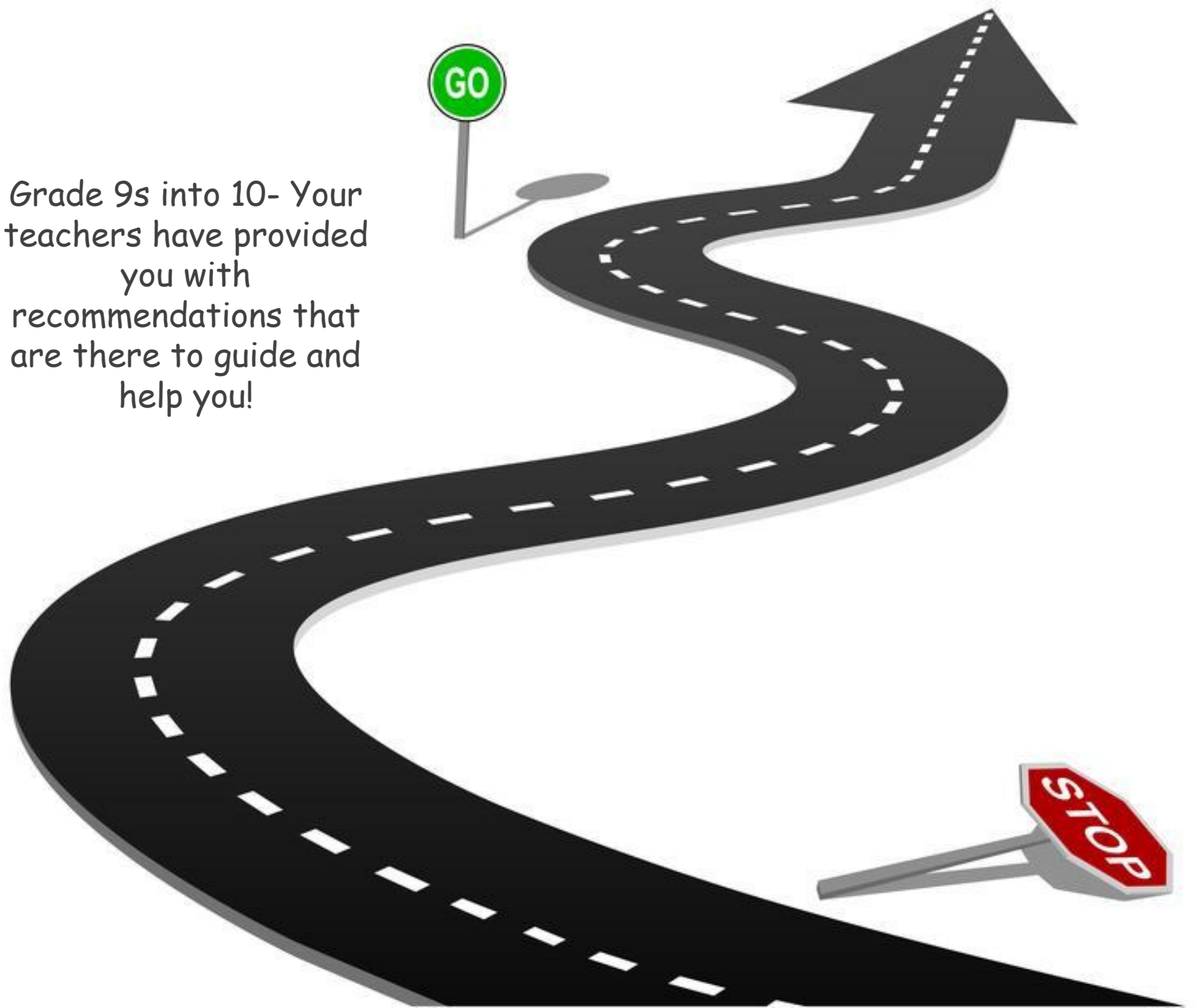
Although only 18 credits are required for graduation. You will graduate with 22-24 courses – 13 of these are compulsory.

NOVA SCOTIA HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION

18 credits

- **English** 3-one at each grade level
- **Fine Arts** 1- Music, Art, Dance or Drama at any grade level
- **Mathematics** 3- one at each grade level
- **Science** 2-one from Bio, Chem, Physics 11 or Sci 10 and one other approved science- Could be an AP
- **Science, Math or** 1 other from Math, Science or Technology Technology
(Comp Programming 12 Exploring Technology, Film &
Video, Textile Technology 12, MultiMedia 12)
- **Physical Education** 1 - PE 10, PE 12,
Dance 11, Fitness LEAD 11, or Yoga 11
- **Social Studies** 1- Mi'kmaw Studies 11, Can His 11 or Afr. Can 11
- **Global Studies** 1- Glob Hist 12 Glob Geog 12, Global Politics 12
AP Human Geography 12

EDUCATION PLANNING CHART- 3 YEAR PLAN

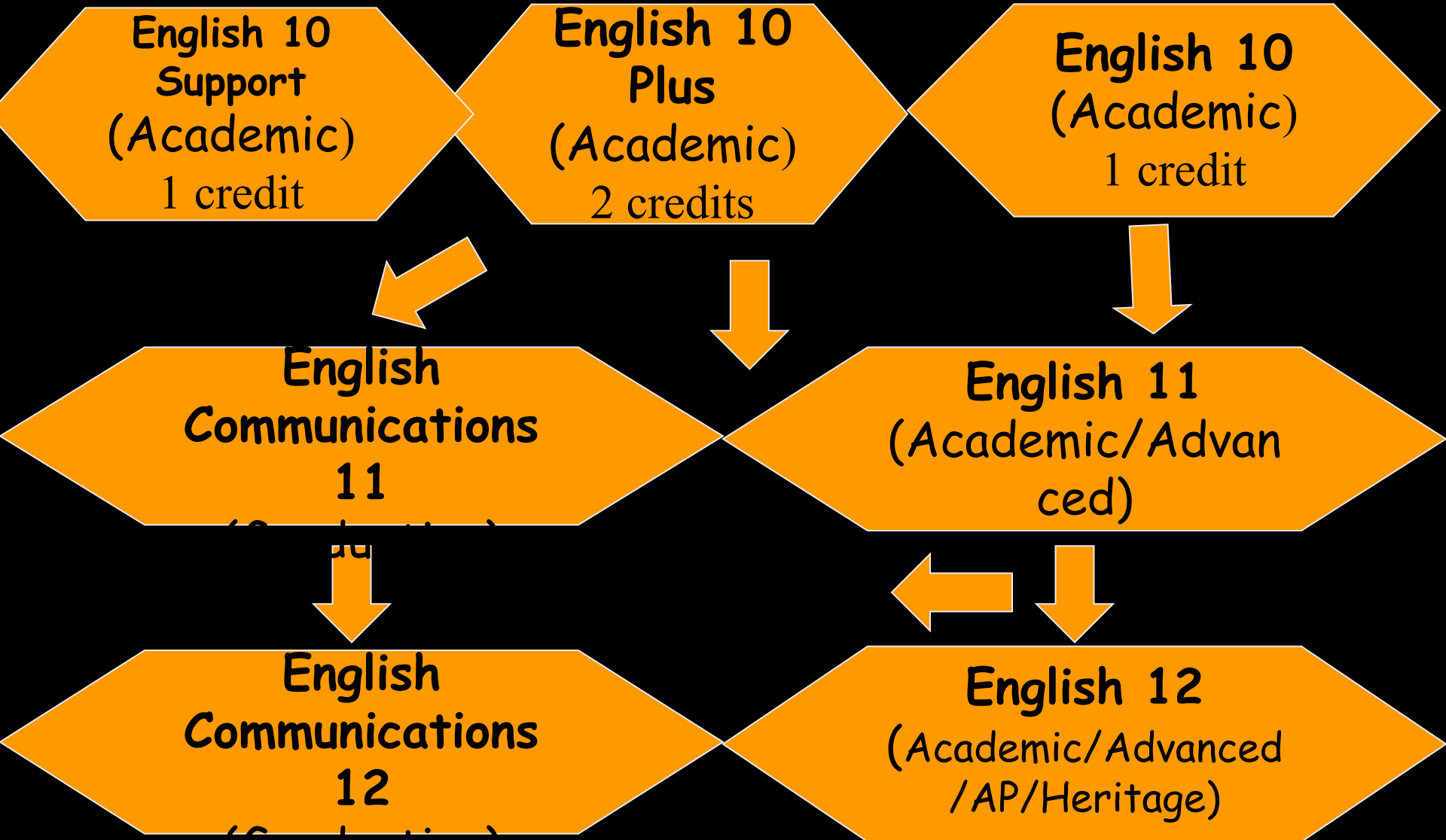

Can I Go to University/College if I Don't Have Academic Math?

- Yes!
- Many university programs do NOT require Academic Math. Important to check. Most SCIENCE based programs require Pre Cal 12.
- Out of 140 programs at college, 80 do NOT require academic math.
- All University programs require top 5 Academic grade 12 grades. (They do look at 11 marks!)
